How to research your Jewish ancestors in England

1. Gather as much information as you can from records, documents, photos and family members



2. Research your ancestors' siblings and wider family, to get more clues



3. Collaborate with other family members and people researching the same families



4. Join the Jewish Genealogical Society of Great Britain. Ask for a mentor, use their Resource Centre and attend talks



5. Take one or more DNA tests to discover relatives



6. Register your details on the JewishGen Family Finder (https://www.jewishgen.org/jgff/)



7. Consider starting a one-name study at https://one-name.org/
